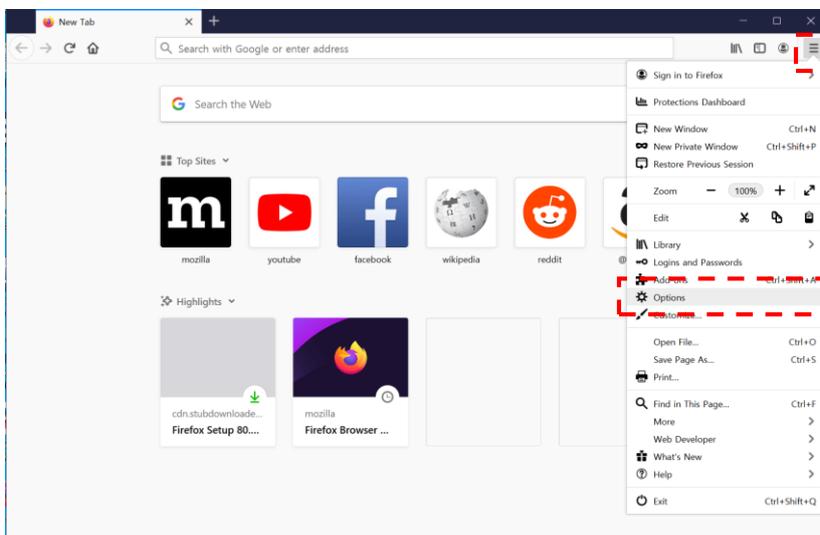

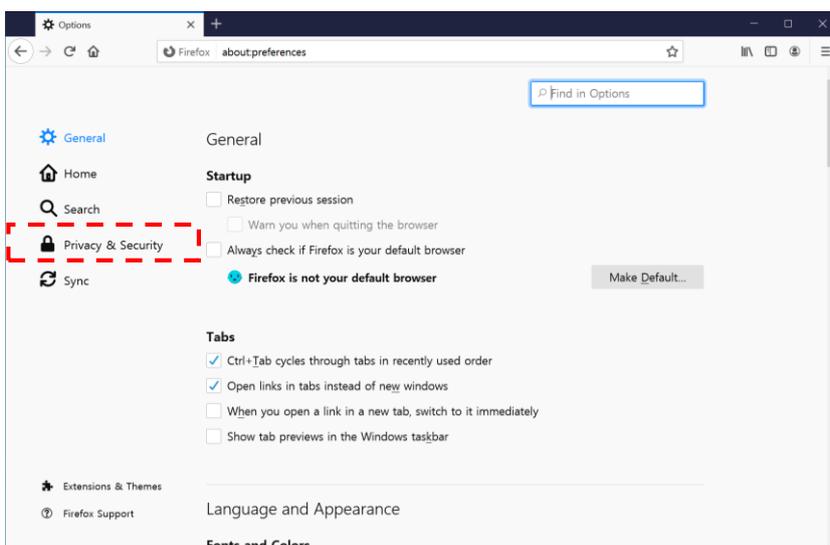
Please note that these steps are necessary only for the use of [umucyo.gov.rw](http://umucyo.gov.rw) on **Firefox**.

Before you access [www.mucyo.gov.rw](http://www.mucyo.gov.rw)

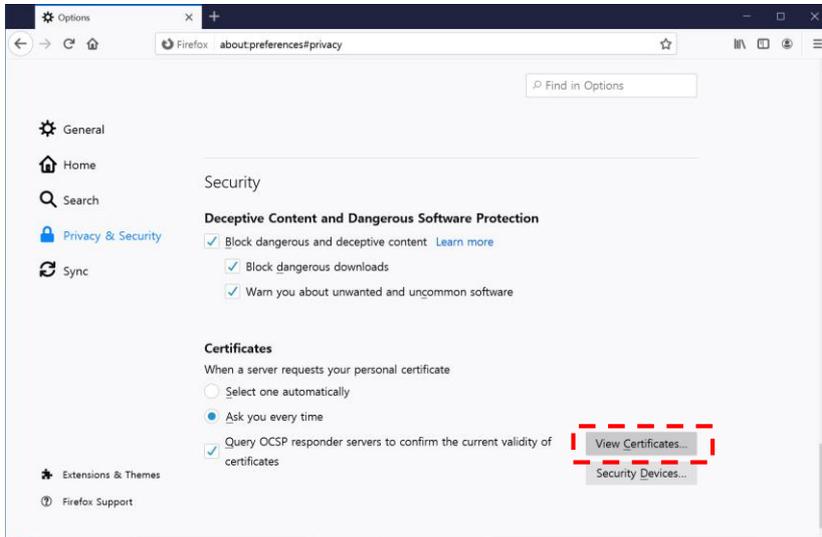
1. Open Firefox and Click 'Option' under open Menu (  ) of Firefox



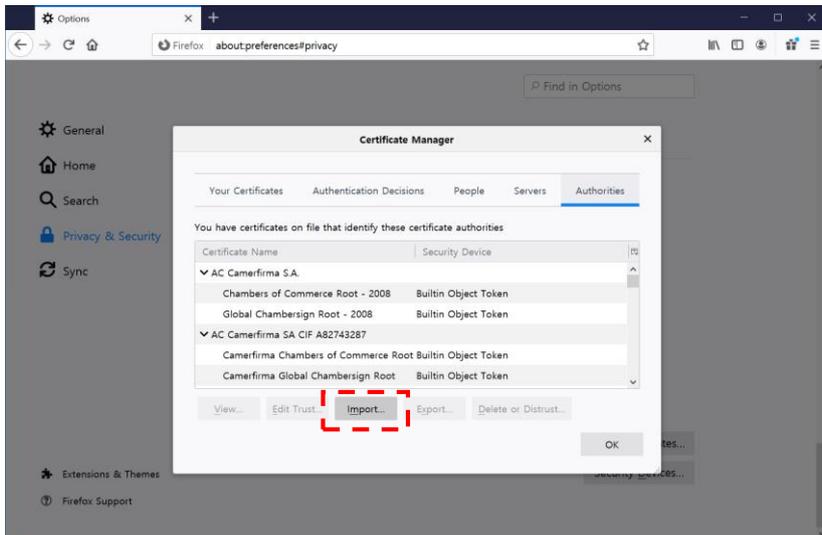
2. Click 'Privacy & Security' under Options



3. Click a button **‘View Certificates’** on tab of ‘Privacy & Security’. (This button is at the bottom)

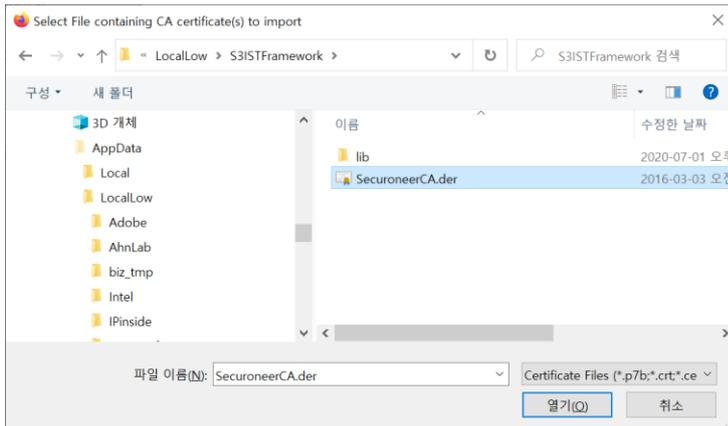


4. Click button **‘Import’** on the popup of ‘View Certificates’.



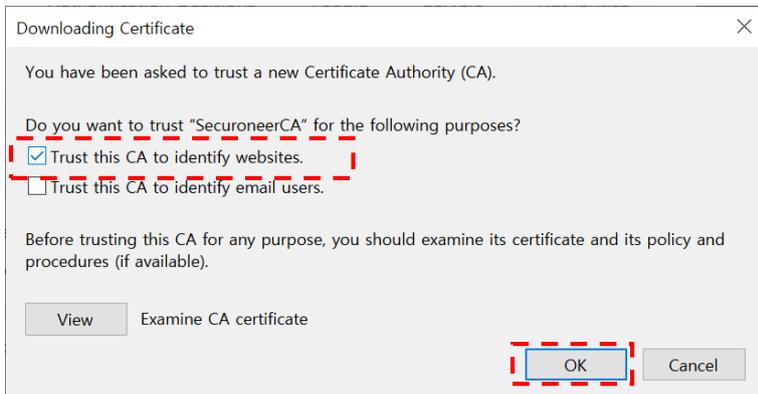
5. Find and Click file **‘SecuroneerCA.der’**. This file is located in the folder as below

```
C:\Users\[user account]\AppData\LocalLow\S3ISTFramework
```

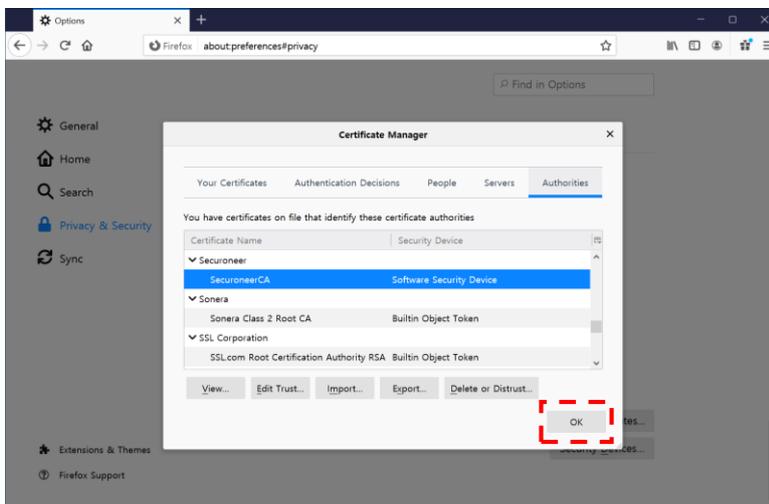


6. Click 'Trust this CA to identify websites'. And Click 'OK'.

(Option 'Trust this CA to identify websites' must be selected. It is very important)



7. After importing, you can see the registered certificate on popup 'Certificate Manager'.
